


# is The Lamplighter

We carry on this tradition with our silver or purple boxes to hold our coins and dollars and also with special envelopes. **Secretary:** Record and circulate the minutes of Executive Committee and Board meetings and the annual meeting • handle correspondence as directed. • serve on a Board committee. • keep a roll of the members of the Board and a record of their attendance at all meetings. • keep one book in which the bylaws and policies are kept up to date. This book shall be available at all meetings of the organization. • give guidance to her counterparts.

**Personal Development Coordinator:** Chair the Personal Development Ministries Working Group to plan and implement the work of this area of ministry, which is designed to provide opportunities for each woman to become and develop as God's person: deepening her faith, developing her gifts, and becoming a more effective Christian disciple and steward.

Church and Community Coordinator: Chair the Church and Community Ministries Working Group to plan and implement the work of this area of ministry, which is designed to provide opportunities for women to build God's faith community: developing relationships with one another, with girls and women of all ages, with their own families and our American Baptist family, with our brothers and sisters of other denominations and women and men in professional church leadership. This area of ministry is also designed to provide opportunities for women to serve their communities by studying issues of concern and involving themselves in meeting the physical and spiritual needs of others in their homes and their communities.

**Members at Large:** Serve on a committee and a ministry working group. • train for major Board responsibilities • serve as a liaison between local women, Associations, and the Board of this organization.

**Chair of AB Girls:** Chair the AB GIRLS Committee in planning AB GIRLS conferences/retreats, using resources and promoting AB GIRLS, serve on the Church and Community Ministries working group. Give guidance to her counterparts.

**Love Gift:** Present the challenge and promote plans for raising the Love Gift for the American Baptist mission. • suggest a yearly Love Gift goal to the Board for recommendation to the organization at the annual meeting. • report information received about Love Gift • serve on the Personal Development Ministries Working Group. • give guidance to her counterparts.

# JLJ CORNER

Who is Jane Loring Jones? Why do the American Baptist Women Ministries of Colorado award this scholarship to Christian young women? In this article read about this amazing Christian woman and how her scholarship was established to honor her service and her interest in helping Christian young women further their education.



Jane Loring Jones was born January 25, 1875, in Maysville, Missouri, daughter of Samuel G. Loring and Francis Giddings Loring. Reared in Maysville, she attended college at Monmouth College in Monmouth, Illinois. She was united in marriage to Robert F. Jones on November 16, 1897, in Maysville, Missouri. They moved to Denver, Colorado, in April 1898, where Mr. Jones became an employee of the Denver Post, in which employment he continued until his death on April 30, 1938, after forty years of continuous relationship.

Jane Loring united with the Baptist Church in Maysville at an early age, and with the Broadway Baptist Church, Denver, in 1903, where she served faithfully for fifty continuous years. She served her denomination as Associational Secretary, Administrative Vice President, and Devotional Leader and Literature Secretary of the Rocky Mountain District. She served as a member of the national Women's Foreign Mission Board now part of the Board of International Ministries, a capacity in which her

daughter-in-law, Martha, also served. Her granddaughter, Anne, has been a member of the General Board of American Baptist Churches and the national Budget Review Officer.

While Devotional Director, Mrs. Jones instituted the observance of the fifth Thursday of each quarter as the Day of Prayer. At the time of her passing, although 78 years of age, she was leading the Women's Baptist Mission Society of Colorado as Spiritual Life Chair. Her influence was always in the interest of the underprivileged, and her voice was raised fearlessly in their behalf. Her passion was that all men everywhere might learn of Christ's redemptive power.

Mrs. Jones suffered for many years from impaired hearing. She served as Treasurer and President of the Denver Hearing Society. Her other services included that of Representative to the Community Chest.

Her influence with younger women was phenomenal. These she referred to as "My Girls." She was the teacher of the Amoma Sunday School Class of the Broadway Baptist Church, Denver, for thirty-two years, and her friends are legion in all walks of life. So many, and so dear!

The American Baptist Women of Colorado (ABWM) adopted the Jane Loring Jones Scholarship Fund in 1954 as a state project. The principal of the Fund is placed in sound investments and the income used exclusively for scholarships each year.
